

RedNet derives from a cross made by Dr. Dean Spaner's program at the University of Alberta, parentage being Carberry, Superb, Alsen & Stanley. RedNet Hard Red Spring Wheat is an awned, hollow-stemmed line with a combination of high yield potential, medium tall plants, and early maturity. Ideal for Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba.

Strengths:

- ✓ Medium maturing
- ✓ Tall but strong straw
- ✓ Very high yielding
- ✓ Good lodging resistance
- ✓ High grain protein
- ✓ Good resistance against the three rusts
- ✓ Elevated Fusarium head blight resistance.
